

# Build a Basic V3 Estimate Form

This document shows you how to build and publish a basic two-page Estimate Form using V3 Forms.

Follow these steps for each page.

## Page 1

Add the following fields:


1. Header - change to say "Estimate Request"
2. Divider
3. Name
4. Contact Email - map to Contact Email
5. Divider
6. Address - map to "Service Address"

## Page 2

Add the following fields:

1. Header - edit to say "Services You Need"
2. Optional Image (or video)  
Add an image of your work (like a nice looking property) or a video showcasing your services
3. Divider
4. Check box field
  - a. Change the Checklist field label to say, "Please select one or more services you're looking for"
  - b. Add or remove checklist options and the names of the options to your services
5. Long Text Entry - Change the label to say: "Do you have any special requests or concerns?"

## Page 1
